Participants said that Keeping Safe[™] has taught them to:



'Speak up when I don't feel safe' (88%)

'Make sure the driver is always safe to drive' (87%)



'Always have a plan to get home safely' (83%)

'Plan to avoid risky situations' (83%)



'Be more confident if faced with risky situations' (80%)

'Make sure the car I am in as a driver/ passenger is safe' (80%)

Two weeks post-program participants said they had used learnings to:



'Avoid risky situations' (71%)

'Be more confident and speak up in risky situations' (70%)



'Be a better driver' (53%)

'Avoid crashes' (50%)

Additionally:



78% discussed the program with parents and friends92% felt free to speak openly and honestly in the program
